**It's Just the Beginning: Abstinence for Dummies**

Ok, so they're not dummies, but they are clueless when it comes to the dangers of sex. This introduction to our 6<sup>th</sup> grade curriculum stresses the importance of setting boundaries before the pressure mounts. Also discussed will be the importance of families in our society and understanding basic human growth and development.

**I'm a Big Kid Now!**

Just because they look grown does not mean they are. Our 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade curricula examine the power of worth that is placed upon sexuality as a reason to abstain until marriage, the media's impact upon our ideas of sexuality, the consequences of pre-marital sex, and practical suggestions for a youth to actively avoid situations that will tempt them towards sex.

**Little Fish, Big Pond**

Can freshman swim against the stream? Our 9<sup>th</sup> grade curriculum examines the uniquely different characteristics of the male/female personality, the effects of media upon our ideas of sexuality, the consequences of pre-marital sex, and practical suggestions on how to avoid having sex or maintaining a commitment to secondary virginity.

**How to Cook a Frog: Ideas have Consequences**

An examination of the overwhelming impact that media has had upon the thought process of youth, with an emphasis upon the progressive nature of media's immorality. Also projecting one of the most significant ideas from the past that has had massive consequences upon our concepts of sexuality.

**Cyber Seduction: A Picture's Worth a Thousand Bucks**

Pornography is a multi-billion dollar industry that is seeking to addict our youth. An examination of the impact that pornography has had on our culture and the physical, mental, and social effects that it causes within our society.

**Sexting: What messages are your kids sending?**

Whether it's blatant child pornography or simply a passing fad, the prevalence of "sexting" has school administrators nationwide concerned. Many districts are taking steps to prevent the latest technological trend - sexting, the sending and receiving of sexually explicit messages or pictures of yourself or someone else over a cell phone. This session will help administrators to be aware of regulations concerning sexting.

**Don't Judge a Book by its Cover**

Every 10 seconds a teenager gets a Sexually Transmitted Disease in West Tennessee. This STD course will be presented by a local Nurse Practitioner. You don't have to be a doctor to talk to your students about their risks.

**Sex Affects: It's Just Sex, Right?**

Wrong. We are not just physical beings and sex affects every part of who we are. Learn how to help your teens prevent and cope with the physical, mental, social, emotional and spiritual consequences of sex.

**Taking It To the Streets**

This training will equip attendees with tips for translating the message of abstinence into your schools daily language. Also discussed will be the state required standards satisfied by this curriculum.
